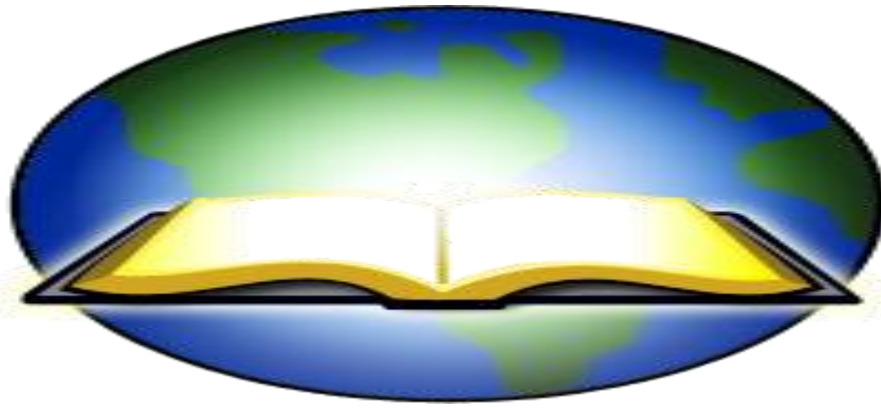

### **THANKS FOR MAKING A DIFFERENCE!**

**Greetings to you in the New Year.** During our devotional studies a few mornings ago, Bob and I were reflecting on our travels and remembering people we have met along the way. In 1981, on a trip to Israel, the Lord sovereignly placed us on a tour bus with a number of senior Christians. At the time, we were among the only persons on board who did not have grey hair. After a few days, these seasoned believers (mostly in their 80's) made Bob chaplain of the bus. It was the beginning of a glorious "hook up" with many of these dear ones.

**When** we arrived back in the USA, we continued to communicate with several of our fellow travelers. Some lived in close proximity to us. One of the ladies discovered that Bob had a great heart for the lost and consequently drafted him to help her evangelize the neighborhood where we lived. Even at that time, she was probably in her early 80's. Sarah introduced to Bob the fine art of presenting the gospel to the lost. Almost every Saturday, they went from house to house, knocking on doors and telling people about Jesus. She also encouraged us to have prayer "shut-ins" at our home once a month. The power of God moved mightily during those times of prayer.

**Another of our** Israel sojourners was a woman of wisdom and prayer. Often we would go and sit at her feet and hear how the Lord had rescued her many times from despair. She had experienced death as an eight or nine year old. However, she also remembers the angels bringing her back to life. One angel said: "It is not your time to come home. There is much more for you to do on earth." Mother Lucy always assured us that things would work out as long as we trusted in the Lord. We experienced such comfort and love in her presence. She was a quiet dynamic presence.

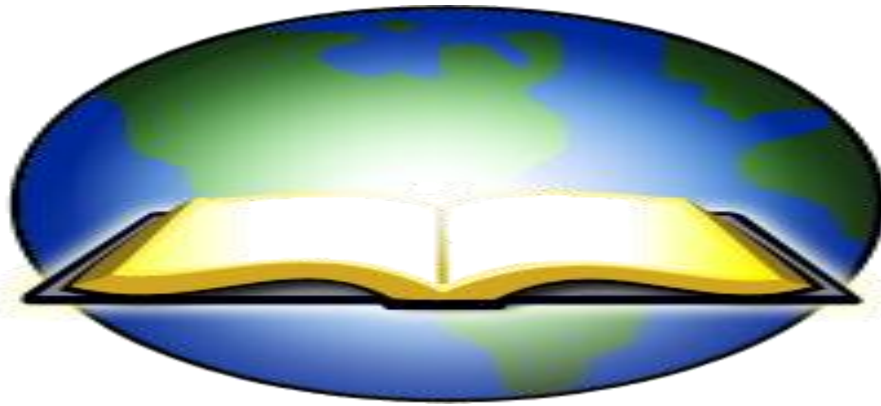
**One of our** memorable flagship Christians was named Cruz. She and her family lived near Denver, Colorado. Often, we would go and visit with her as our daughter was attending the University of Denver. Cruz had a special way of leading people to the Lord. She was surefooted, quick and sold out to Jesus. I have never known anyone before or since who had such a special anointing in this area. Her joy was to share how God had walked her through 39 years of caring for a totally incapacitated down's syndrome son. "Bobby" could neither talk, turn or move. The things that God taught her about life and its challenges gave particular tools for sharing her testimony with others.

**Cruz was** a great prayer warrior. As we were getting to know each other in Israel, she revealed that she prayed at 12 midnight each night. When we came back home to Southern California, I would frequently call her with my list of prayer requests. When she answered the phone, she would always say.....okay Madelyn, let me get my pencil. We would both laugh and I would give her my litany of requests.

**One of the things** that Cruz did later in life was to take a great interest in those who attended her rather large church. She talked to the pastor-shepherd about her sense of people getting "lost" in the congregation. Even though there were Bible Studies and Cell Groups gatherings, she was troubled and wanted to do something specific to make a difference.

**The Lord gave her** an idea that she passed on to Pastor. Cruz asked for a master list of all the members. Her goal was to invite 2 couples at a time to her home. Sunday evening at 6 p.m. was the appointed day and time. These couples could not bring their children as this period was set aside just for them. They were given ample notice to find sitters. Meeting at her warm home over coffee, tea and dessert would give them this special opportunity to share and commiserate. There was an intimacy and caring that came forth from these meetings. Each couple would be affirmed and know that there was at least one person in the church praying for them specifically. Cruz also had a time where single parents would come and be affirmed along these lines. She was instrumental in helping them with their Christian walk.

**Seems as if** it took Cruz several years to get around to hosting the entire congregation 2 couples at a time. Of course, she had a never ending supply of people coming and going. However, as a Christ follower, she used this opportunity to make a difference.
