**On a trip to Mexico** this summer, Bob experienced some discomfort in the right side of his jaw. He ended up seeing a doctor for this worsening condition. His experience was a unique one. Bob states that his appointment was one that was apparently set in motion by God. When he arrived at clinic, the doctor soon called him in. As he walked into the office, "old bones" started taking about God. He told Bob he was glad that the U.S. Constitution was created by God-aware men. Further saying that he himself did not know how to relate to God. He seemed very confused on the God issue. There were so many questions, followed by intellectual dead-ends for which he had no answers, but was still searching.

**As Bob** shared his story with me, he said "Madelyn, I don't think I was there to get treatment for my jaw. I believe the encounter with the doctor was by divine order." Even as the physician had a waiting room full of patients, he continued to ply Bob with questions about God. The doctor talked almost non-stop and kept Bob in his office for about 45 minutes. At the end of the visit, the doctor handed Bob a prescription to be used if needed. Bob in turn pulled out a single Bible tract from his pocket and handed it to the doctor saying,

What a pleasure to read of the recently initiated "**Soldier On**" Program. This project addresses the needs of veterans who are in some type of transition. In January, a housing development was birthed by a joint program of the US Dept of Veterans Affairs and other agencies. Particular properties are now being designed to help make new housing available for homeless vets. A new community has been built in a part of Massachusetts specifically to help these veterans. More veterans housing is on the drawing board for other parts of the State. This non-profit project works to provide shelter, support and job training for homeless vets. The success of this program has been heartwarming. We pray that it expands nationwide.
